

## INTERVIEW TIPS

---

1. Be yourself and set yourself apart by talking about things you enjoy and are passionate about outside of school work. Employers already know you are smart because you're a UW Madison engineer!
2. Think of meaningful questions to ask employers. It shows enthusiasm and interest in the company.
3. Practice, practice, practice for the technical parts of the interview!
4. Do informational interviews.
5. Reach out to upperclassmen to hear about their experiences.
6. Let your personality show!
7. Be sure to dress appropriately. Business attire should be worn for full-time interviews. Business casual is appropriate for career fairs and internship/co-op interviews.
